# Thoughts from your Community Lay Director

I have just completed my first Chrysalis Flight! I was just a Board Representative, but what a unique way to observe the transformation of young men and women into Butterflies and I would recommend and encourage any of you who have not had this opportunity, to pray and listen if Christ is leading you into the Conference Room as a leader or mentor to Caterpillars or Pilgrims. If nothing else, reach out to strengthen this Community through Sponsorship! It is the only way this Community will continue to grow and spread the message of Christ's Kingdom.

Speaking of Sponsorship, it's never too early to begin asking those who God has put on your heart to complete an application for the Fall Walks in October. Our teams are formed and training begins August 4th. Delaying applications and decisions causes our Walk Lay Directors and PCE Board the undue stress of possibly canceling a Walk. Consequently, we have done appointments for a 1 year term which has met the need, but doesn't provide continuity. We will continue appointments as necessary if you wish to serve only 1 year, so again I ask that you pray and listen for Christ's call to serve in any of the positions listed below. I'm happy to provide the detail of any position or I suggest you simply talk with the current Board member about the position details. Chrysalis was a Success!! 9 Boys and 6 Girls attended. A huge thanks to everyone that sponsored and worked the Walks.




