The third worm was put into a container of chocolate syrup.

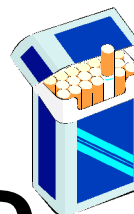
The fourth worm was put into a container of good clean soil.

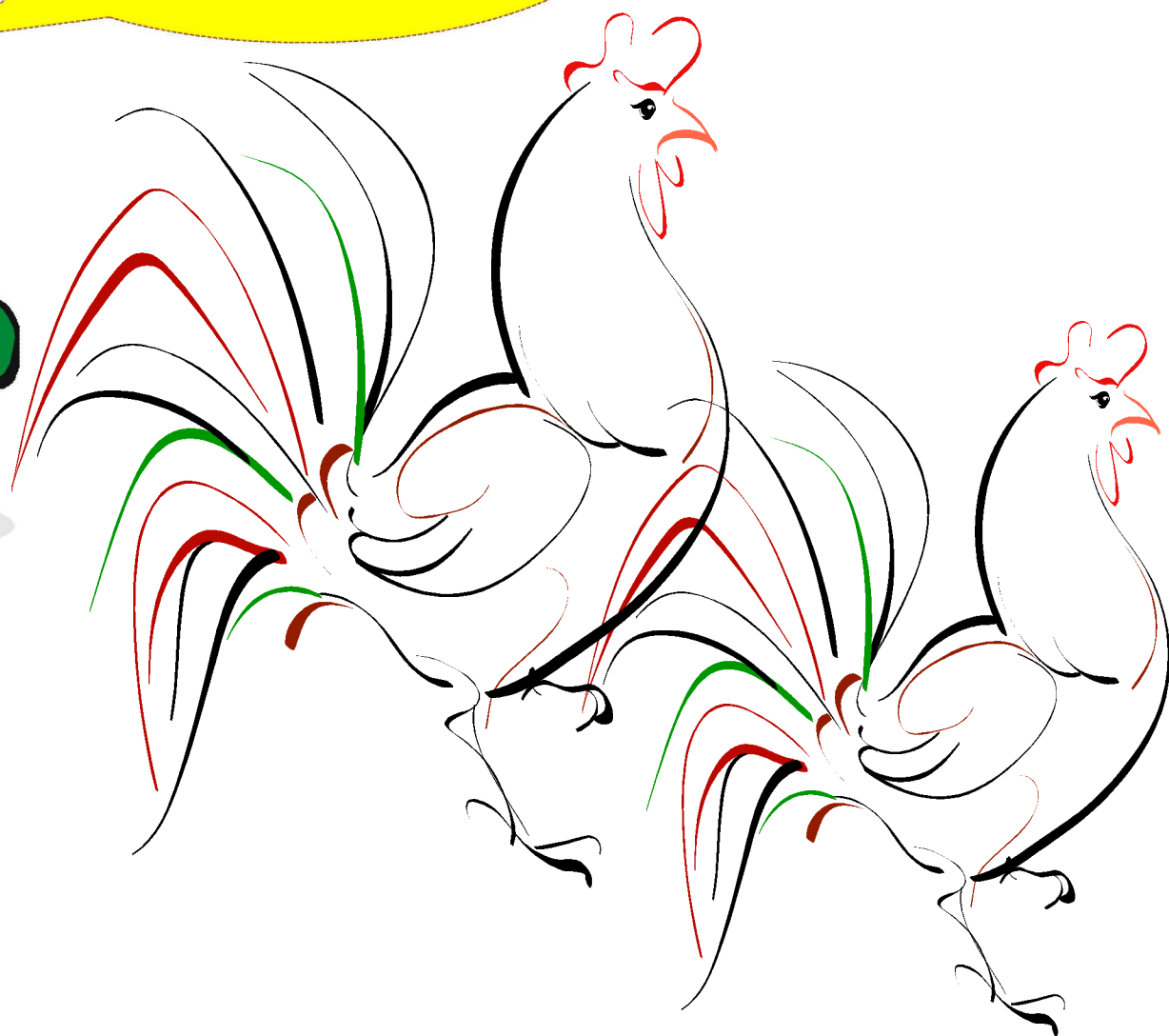
