The Women's Walk will begin on Thursday, March 20th and will conclude on Sunday, March 23rd. Fourth Day will be on Thursday, March 27th.

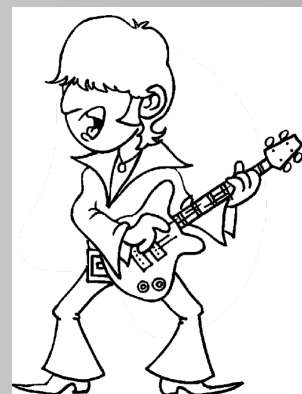

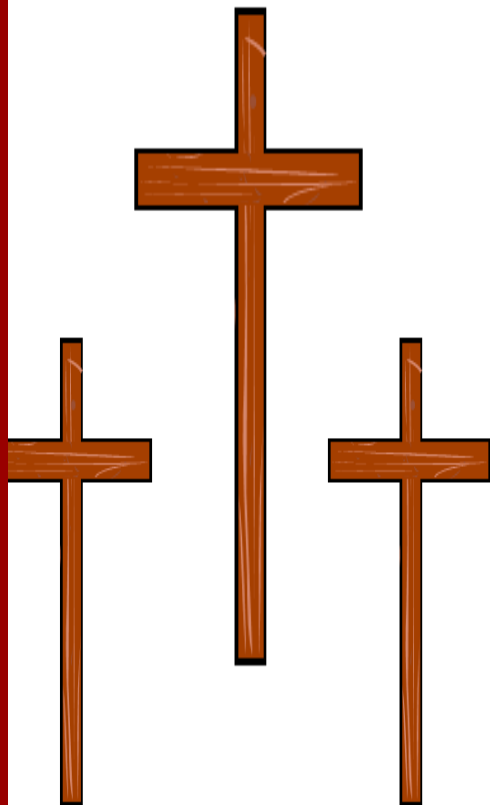
