The Men's Walk is October 2-5 with Jim Hinckley as the Lay Director, and the Women's Walk follows two weeks later on October 16-19 with Becky Parker as the Lay Director. Both Walks will be held at First UMC, 131 NW 4th Street, in downtown Oklahoma City.

You are welcome to come help set up on the Wednesday evening before the Walk and to help tear down on the Sunday of the Walk. These times vary and an e-mail will be sent out beforehand with the times.

If your desire is to be a Manager in the Kitchen, Dining Room, Snack Room, Agape Room, Prayer Room, or Team Assistant Manager, you must have worked an entire Walk weekend in the area in which you would like to server as a Manager. If you meet this requirement and are willing to serve, please contact the Lay Director of the Walk.

Help is always needed in the Kitchen, Dining Room, and the Agape Room before and after meals, especially on Friday and Saturday mornings. The meal times are as follows:

If you have plenty of time to spare, come to the Kitchen any morning, check in with the Kitchen Manager, who will be wearing a red apron, and ask where help is needed. If your time is more restricted, show up an hour before any meal to help finalize meal preparation, serve plates, and clean up afterwards. Immediately after clean-up, the Dining Room will need to be set up for the next meal.

You might also want to look at the Prayer Room schedule, which is posted in the Kitchen and try to visit before, during, or after one of the Speakers.

This will give you a well-rounded view of where the needs are for every Walk, and you can decide where you best like to serve. We look forward to seeing you behind the scenes!

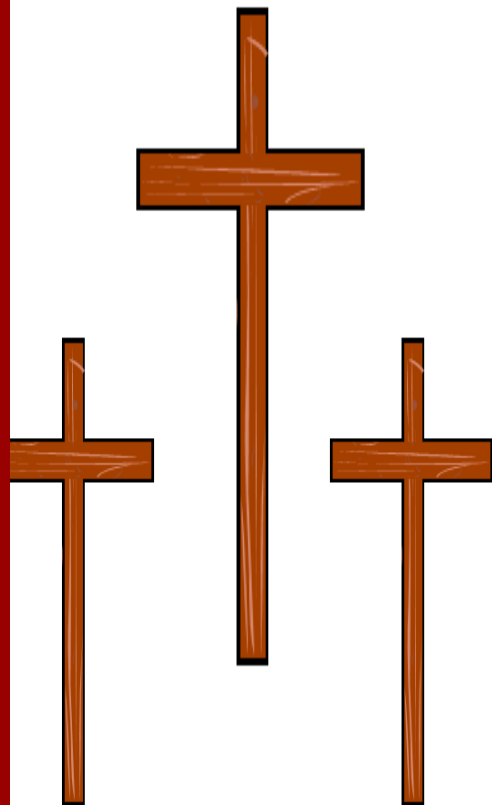
