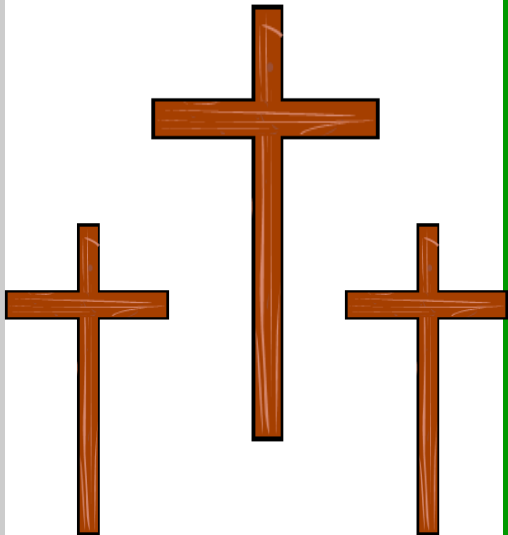

# NEW WEBSITE



The new Pioneer Country Emmaus & Chrysalis website is still being developed, but you can use it as we continue to develop it and make improvements. If you do not have your username and password, don't worry, there is still plenty of content available.

For example, you can access announcements for both Emmaus and Chrysalis, application packets for both pilgrims and sponsors, newsletters and upcoming events on the calendar page, all without a password from the landing (home) page. You can

even print anything you need such as application packets or newsletters. You can even view and print maps of the event locations. It's all very user friendly.

Other things you can do without a password include sign up on the prayer vigil on the Prayer Vigil page. By going to the links page, you will find links to other Emmaus Community websites and other related sites. The introductory videos for Emmaus and Chrysalis are there as well ... a very useful introductory tool for prospective Caterpillars and Pilgrims.

All that is available to everyone, without signing in to the website. When you do login, you will also see a Contacts page, which lists all the board members for Emmaus, the Chrysalis Steering Committee, and the Web Administrators. On the forums page, you can ask questions of the board, post prayer requests, updates, and have general discussions with other Emmaus members. Chrysalis members have their own forum as well.

If signed in, you can utilize the services page to order a new nametag, lanyard or cross. You can also use this area to fill out the volunteer service sheet. By clicking on your name, you can update your address, phone numbers, email addresses and change your password.

Currently the web administrators are developing tools for the board members to use. In the future, there will be more community functions. We will keep you advised as they become available. If you do not have your username and password yet, board members are available to sign you up at Gatherings, or you can call any board member or web administrator. Sending user names and passwords through email is not secure and therefore highly discouraged.
