

Please, members, contact your friends and family members, and invite them to come enjoy this time with us. There's no better way to get to know folks than to come and eat and worship with Holy Communion together. Potential candidates for upcoming walks would certainly enjoy the chance to socialize and get a feel for what our Emmaus Community is like.

Our Pioneer Country Emmaus Gathering for October 2021 will be held at New Covenant UMC, 2700 South Boulevard, Edmond, OK.

From Stillwater, about 54 min (52.3 mi) via OK-33 W and I-35 S. Follow I35 South. Keep left at the fork to stay on I-35 S, follow signs for Okla. City/Dallas. Take exit 139 toward S.E 33RD St. Keep left to take the ramp toward BOYS RANCH TOWN. Turn left onto W I 35 Frontage Rd.

Take the 1st right onto E 33rd St. Turn right onto S Boulevard. 2700 S BOULEVARD is on the right.

From Enid, about 1 hour and 23 min (88.9 mi) via US 412 E and I35 South. Take 412 East . Take the exit onto I-35 S/US-64 E toward Perry/Okla. City. Keep left at the fork to stay on I-35 S, follow signs for Okla. City/Dallas. Take exit 139 toward S.E 33RD St. Keep left to take the ramp toward BOYS RANCH TOWN. Turn left onto W I 35 Frontage Rd.

Take the 1st right onto E 33rd St. Turn right onto S Boulevard. 2700 S BOULEVARD is on the right .

From Moore, about 27 min (21.7 mi) via US77N . Take US77N to 33rd. Turn right onto E 33rd St. Turn left onto S Boulevard. 2700 S BOULEVARD is on the right.

From Piedmont, about 31 min (17.3 mi) via NW 178th St to NW 164th St. Edmond Rd becomes NW 178th St. Pass through 1 roundabout. Turn right onto N Portland Ave/OK-74 S. Turn left onto NW 164th St. NW 164th St becomes W 15Th St. Turn right onto S Boulevard. 2700 S BOULEVARD is on the left
