



Letter from our Lay Director

Emmaus and Disaffiliation

As many are aware, several churches within the Oklahoma United Methodist Conference are, or have been thru, the process of discernment leading to a decision regarding one's continuing affiliation with the United Methodist Church. This article is not meant to enter into any discussion as to the reasons for/ against the disaffiliation process or the ultimate decision to or not to disaffiliate. This article is meant to define what disaffiliation means to Emmaus.

At the highest level, disaffiliation should have little impact on the conduct of our monthly gatherings or the conduct of the Walk to Emmaus Weekends. To understand what I mean, one has to remember a founding principle of the Walk to Emmaus, as established by the Upper Room. The Walk to Emmaus is an ecumenical activity and is to be offered as, and conducted as, an ecumenical activity. Listed below are some definitions of ecumenical.

Representing a number of different Christian Churches

Of relating to or representing the whole of a body of churches

Promoting or trending towards Worldwide Christian Unity or Cooperation.

As such, Pioneer Country Emmaus has opened the doors to Christians from several denominations throughout central Oklahoma. We have had many Walk Participants and Walk Leaders from non-Methodist churches. Likewise, we have had several non-Methodist as board members and serve in PCE leadership positions.

It is the PCE Boards intention to continue to promote and operate as an ecumenical organization. Yes, the PCE Board recognizes that Christian churches throughout our state and the country are in decline, and therefore it creates a concern moving forward. My personnel hope and prayer is that PCE Emmaus, as well as all Oklahoma Emmaus Communities will enter into a process to "<u>rekindle"</u> in us the fire of the Holy Spirit.


