

**From Stillwater**, about 1 hr and 10 min (77 mi) via Kilpatrick Turnpike and I-35 S . Follow I35 South. Take exit 138B to merge onto Kilpatrick Turnpike West. Take the exit onto SW 15th St. Turn left onto SW 15th St

**From Enid,** about 1 hour and 23 min (77 mi) via NW Expressway and Kilpatrick Turnpike. Take SH-3 E ,Turn right onto N Morgan Rd, merge onto Kilpatrick Turnpike W. Take the exit onto SW 15th St. Turn left onto SW 15th.

**From Moore,** about 25 min (22 mi) via I40W and I35. Merge onto I-35 North. Take exit 1B on the left to merge onto I-40 W toward Amarillo. Take exit 140 onto Morgan Rd, Continue onto S Morgan Rd, turn right onto SW 15th.

**From Piedmont,** about 20 min (17 mi) via NW Expressway and Kilpatrick Turnpike. Take SH-3 E ,Turn right onto N Morgan Rd, merge onto Kilpatrick Turnpike W. Take the exit onto SW 15th St. Turn left onto SW 15th St.

Who remembers sleeping on foam mattresses? How would you like cots instead? Your Emmaus Board is working on getting enough cots to replace the current foam mattresses. If you would like to help sponsor this project, please reach out to a board member.



Our fund raising to buy folding cots to replace the foam mattresses is going well. We still need more donations in order to purchase 75 cots. These cots are priced at nearly \$100.00 each. We have a couple of anonymous donors who will match whatever we raise. This is the cot we will probably buy. They are easy to set up and take down. They will hold up to 500 pounds, have a cushion, and are long enough to hold a 6-foot-tall person.
