This Month in History...

- September 1, 1983 Korean Airlines Flight# 007 is shot down by Soviet fighters, killing 269 aboard
- September 2, 1969 First ATM is placed in service at Chemical Bank in Rockville Center, New York
- September 3, 1777 The American flag (Stars and Stripes) was flown in battle for the first time
- September 4, 1957 Arkansas National Guard prevents nine African-american students from attending the all-white Central High School in Little Rock
- September 5, 1964 *House of the Rising Sun* by the Animals reaches #1 on the U.S. pop charts
- September 6, 1943 New high-speed train derails while travelling from New York City and Washington, DC, killing 79 people and injuring nearly 100 more
- September 7, 1911 31-year old poet Guillaume Apollinaire is arrested for stealing the *Mona Lisa*
- September 8, 1974 President Gerald Ford pardons former President Richard Nixon
- September 9, 1919 Boston Police Department goes on strike, criminals take advantage
- September 10, 1897 First drunk driving arrest is made in London. Taxi driver George Smith (no relation) pled guilty and pad a fine of 25 shillings
- September 11, 2001 Two hijacked Boeing 767 airliners hit the World Trade Center towers in NYC , killing close to 3,000 people, including 343 firefighters and paramedics, 23 NYC police officers, and 37 Port Authority police officers
- September 12, 1972 Actor William Boyd (Hopalong Cassidy) rides off into his last sunset at age 77
- September 13, 1971 29 inmates and 10 hostages are killed in a four-day riot at Attica Prison in New York
- September 14, 1974 Eric Clapton's *I Shot the Sheriff* hits #1 on the music charts
- September 15, 1958 Commuter train 3314 plunges off a bridge into Newark Bay, killing 47 passengers
- September 16, 1893 More than 100,000 people pour into the Cherokee Strip of Oklahoma in largest land run
- September 17, 1976 NASA unveils it's first space shuttle, the *Enterprise*, which cost nearly \$10 billion to develop
- September 18, 1974 Actress Doris Day wins a \$22.8 million malpractice suit against her former lawyer
- September 19, 1957 The United States detonates a 1.7 kiloton nuclear weapon in an underground test site 65 miles north of Las Vegas
- September 20, 1975 The Bay City Rollers make their U.S. debut on Saturday Night Live with Howard Cosell
- September 21, 1985 A little-known actor named George Clooney makes his TV debut on *The Facts of Life*
- September 22, 1862 President Abraham Lincoln issues the Emancipation Proclamation, freeing more than 3 million black slaves
- September 23, 1908 A controversial call at second base gives the Chicago Cubs the National League pennant over the New York Giants
- September 24, 1789 President George Washington signs the Judiciary Act of 1789, establishing the Supreme Court of the United States
- September 25, 1978 A Boeing 727 collides with a single-engine Cessna 1732 over San Diego and crash into a neighborhood, killing 144 on the 727, the two Cessna pilots, and 7 people on the ground. Twenty-two homes in San Diego's North Park neighborhood were destroyed
- September 26, 1957 *West Side Story* premieres on Broadway
- September 27, 1938 President Franklin D. Roosevelt appeals to Adolph Hitler for peace. Hitler declines
- September 28, 1941 Boston Red Sox' Ted Williams becomes the last player to hit .400
- September 29, 1988 Stacy Allison of Portland, Oregon becomes the first American woman to reach the summit of Mount Everest, the highest point on earth at 29,035 feet above sea level
- September 30, 1889 The Wyoming state convention grants women the right to vote



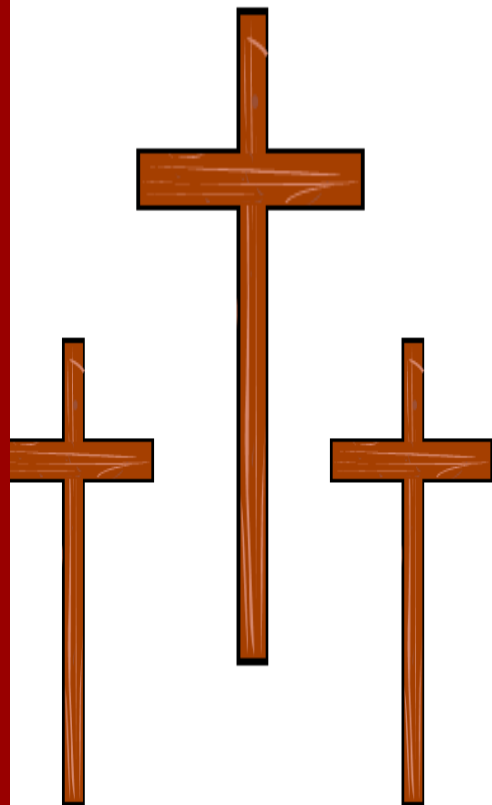

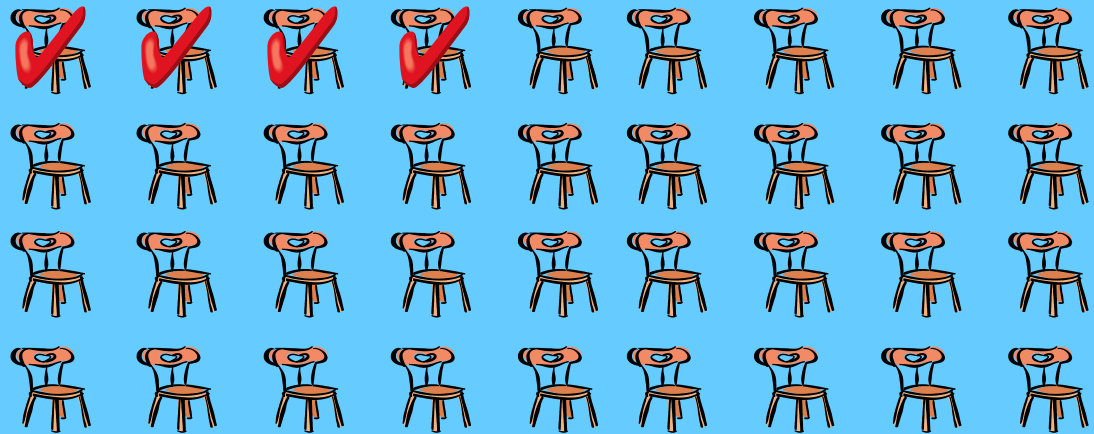
