

**BALLOT FOR 2024 BOARD MEMBERS
PIONEER COUNTRY EMMAUS**

Each ballot must be signed by the voter and the voter’s name legibly printed beneath the signature. There are two columns for voting. If two people are using this ballot for voting, then both must sign the ballot at the bottom. Each person votes for 5 candidates (including any write in candidates you add to the ballot. If an error is made, cross out the wrong mark and initial beside it. If six or more votes are made by a voter only the first five will be counted. A vote will be indicated by marking an “X” in the box by the candidate’s name. Names can be written in on the ballot.

Note: Peety Luka has served on the PCE Board previously. The remaining 4 candidates are currently serving on the board put joined this past summer and have never stood for election. All have expressed their desire to serve on the PCE Board.
