

- JESUS JOINS MEN WHO ARE ALREADY BELIEVERS
- FAITH IS "RE-EXPLAINED"
- GRACE IS "RE-EXPERIENCED"
- THESE MEN ARE "RE-TURNED" TO CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY TO SHARE THEIR EXPERIENCE

PURPOSEFUL SPONSORING

- Church Leaders
- Dependable Church Members
- Less Active Members
- Christians Hungry for "something more"
- Christians who want to grow spiritually
- Members & leaders representing a cross section of the Church and Society
- Respected laypesrsons & clergypersons

QUESTIONABLE SPONSORSHIP

- Non-Christians & individuals without an ACTIVE relationship in the local church. Emmaus is a discipleship building event rather than an evangelistic outreach
- Individuals suffering emotional or psychological trauma. They may need to wait until a later Walk, when they can participate fully.
- Individuals who decide not to attend after being presented the opportunity
- Christians whose theology and/or practice is notably different or incompatible
- Individuals who are always looking for another spiritual high or experience to help them "arrive"

HOW DO YOU SPONSOR

- Pray for individual's openness to God's Call
- Make an appointment to explain logistics
- Get a commitment and help with application process
- Gather Agape Letters (No Gifts, please!)
- Participate in the 72 hour Prayer Vigil
- Bring Pilgrim to Send-Off and attend Sponsor's Hour afterward
- Make Pilgrim's bed, lay out their PJ's, open their Bible to Luke 24:13, and lay it on their pillow
- Attend Candlelight & Closing
- Work behind-the-scenes during the Weekend
- Bring your Pilgrim to their 4th Day meeting and encourage their involvement
- Help your Pilgrim find a Reunion Group
- Invite your Pilgrim to Gatherings and offer a ride
- Help your Pilgrim find ways to act out their new commitment

The weekend changed my life. It made me realize just how important God is to me, and how much I need Him in my life. I wanted all my friends to have that experience. AND I knew, without a doubt, what I was going to do. I was going to pass on the Gift of Sponsorship. When I did, I again experienced that love and grace our Lord Jesus gives us so freely and unconditionally. It was amazing to be on the outside looking in!


New Covenant UMC, Edmond, OK


