Our Pioneer Country Emmaus Gathering for October, 2019, will be held at New Hope United Methodist Church, 11600 North Council Road, Oklahoma City.

From Stillwater, about 1 hour 3 min (65.6 mi) via OK-33 W and I-35 S. US-177 South to Okla Hwy 33 west. Take Interstate 35 S toward Oklahoma City. Take Kilpatrick Turnpike to Rockwell Ave exit. Merge onto W Memorial Rd. Turn left onto N Council Rd. 11600 N Council Rd, Oklahoma City, OK 73162.

From Enid, about 1 h 24 min (76.8 mi) via OK-74 S. US-412 E/E Owen K Garriott Rd to OK-15 E/OK-74 exit toward Garber/Covington. Turn right onto NW 248th St/Azalea St/W Waterloo Rd. Turn left onto N Council Rd. 11600 N Council Rd, Oklahoma City, OK 73162.

From Moore, about 32 min (29.6 mi) via I-35 N. Take I-35 N/US-77 N. Continue onto I-235 N/US-77 N (signs for Oklahoma Health Center). Take US-77 N to Kilpatrick Turnpike. Take exit toward Rockwell Ave. Merge onto W Memorial Rd. Turn left onto N Council Rd. 11600 N Council Rd, Oklahoma City, OK 73162.

From Piedmont, about 15 min (8.8 mi) via Piedmont Rd N and Northwest Expy. From Piedmont Rd N, Turn left onto Northwest Expy. Turn left onto W Hefner Rd. Turn left onto N Council Rd. 11600 N Council Rd, Oklahoma City, OK 73162.
